

India on track to meet climate goals, says FM

'Among select G20 nations set to do so'

India is among the few G20 countries on track to meet United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and Paris Agreement goals and has taken decisive actions to tackle climate change, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Wednesday.

The Minister, in a meeting with COP 26 president-designate Alok Sharma, said the government is taking concrete steps and at 'appreciable speed' to meet its commitments on the target of 450 GW of renewable energy by 2030. She also said 100 GW of this had already been achieved.

The Minister discussed issues related to climate change and specifically COP 26, the 26th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties, the Finance Minister said in a statement.

The U.K. will host the international climate conference COP 26 in November this year.
